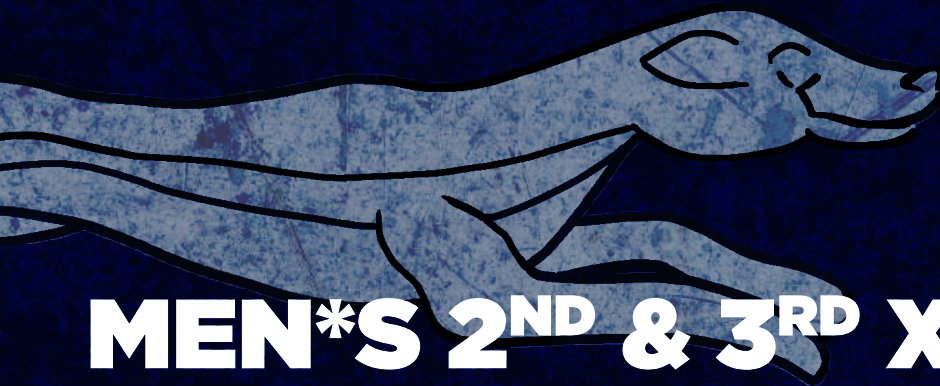

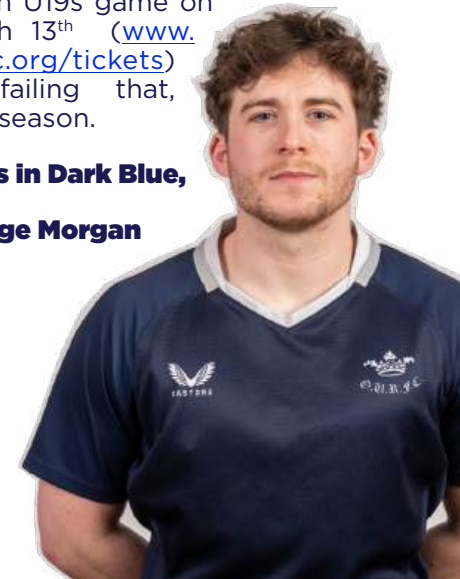

# OURFC WELCOMES THE JAPANESE AMBASSADOR

OURFC are very honoured to receive the Ambassador of Japan to the UK, Hiroshi Suzuki, to award the trophy to the victors of the Greyhounds vs LX Club match.

Ambassador Suzuki has been in post since September 2024. A graduate of the University of Tokyo, he was Ambassador to India immediately before this current posting. He was a former colleague and close friend of OURFC's Ambassador Katsuhiko Oku who was tragically killed on diplomatic duty in Iraq in November 2003.

OURFC has a special relationship with the nation of Japan, and we are delighted to host the Ambassador during his visit, ahead of the 13<sup>th</sup> March fixture between an OURFC representative team and the Japan U19 squad. This relationship

began in September 1952 when Oxford was the first international team to travel to Japan after the end of World War Two seven years earlier. Giles Bullard's squad of twenty-four players travelled to Japan and established an enduring friendship which exists into the present day.

One of the teams played in the 1952 tour was a combined side from Kyoto, Dohshisha, and Kanseigakuin Universities, another relationship which has grown into the twenty first century. In 2023, the Men's Greyhounds embarked on their first international tour to Japan, playing Kyoto on the hundredth anniversary of both rugby teams. Though the teams met on the pitch for the first time two years ago, the link has been long established in the shared Dark Blue (adopted by Kyoto in 1920) as well as the exchange of alumni players since 1980.

This year, the Japan U19s squad, after finishing high school in February will then travel to England to play Oxford on March 13<sup>th</sup>. Three days later, they take on a Saracens Academy team before an England U19s team put together specifically to face them on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> March at Cambridge RFC.

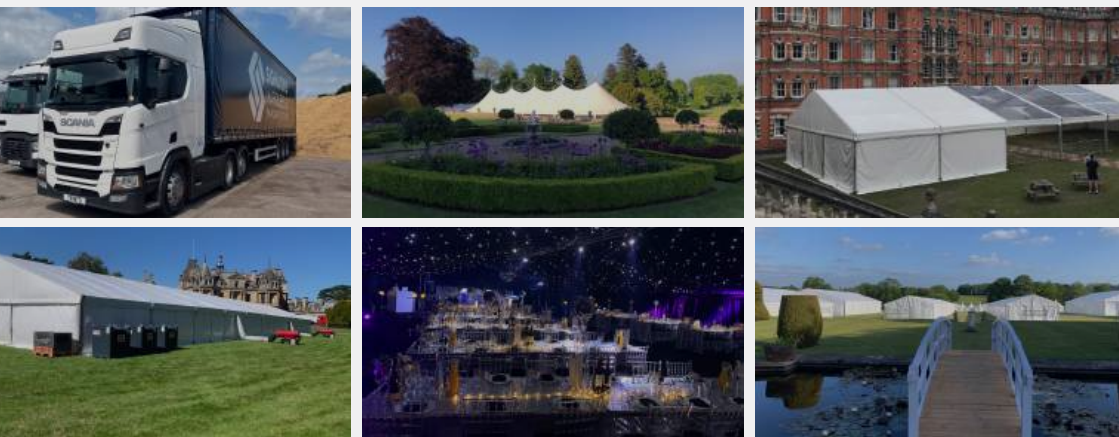

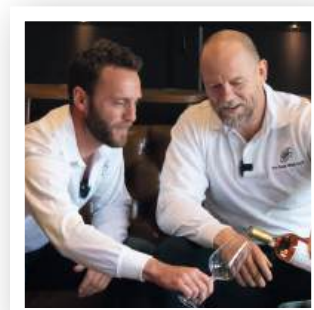

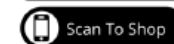
