PRESIDENT'S WORD

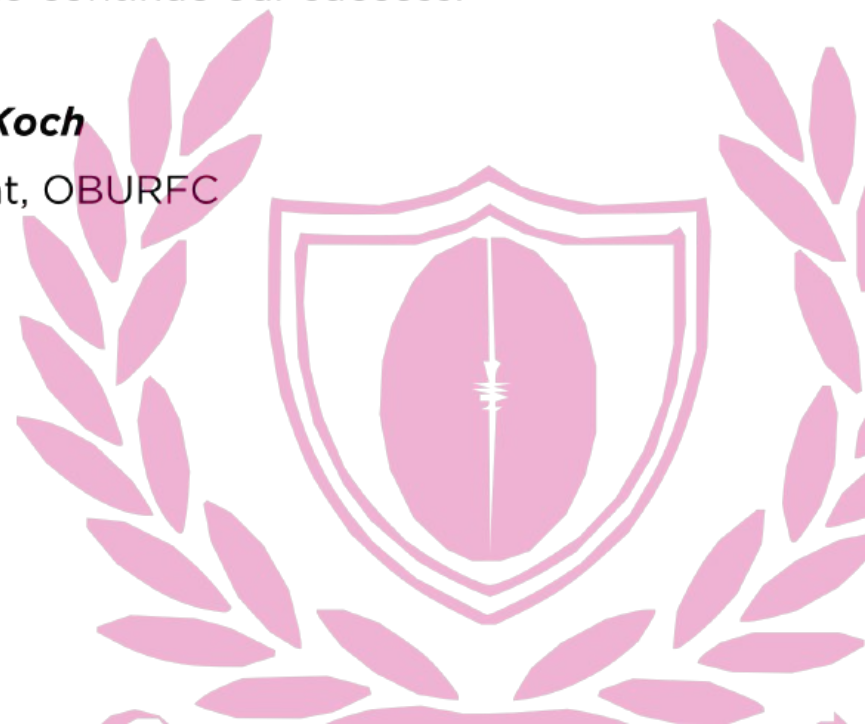
TRISTAN KOCH, OBURFC
